

UNIFORM DRESS CODE

Shirts and Blouses

Girls and boys may wear

1. Short or long-sleeved plain white, navy blue, dark purple polo shirts with no identifying logo/print or shirts with official school logo.
2. Long-sleeved white or navy turtle-necks (not mock turtle-necks)
3. Girls may wear short or long-sleeved white Peter Pan collared blouses with navy blue or khaki jumper.
4. St. Michael's School t-shirts with uniform bottoms may be worn on Wednesdays unless otherwise informed. These may be purchased through the school office.

During colder weather, students may wear a plain long sleeved white, dark purple, or navy shirt under their uniform. No other colors will be allowed.

Pants, Shorts, Skirts & Skorts

Girls and boys may wear

1. Khaki or navy blue pants (no denim) that are pleated in the front or flat and have no external pockets (such as on cargo pants). Jean style pockets are not allowed.
2. Khaki or navy blue shorts (no denim) that are pleated in the front or flat and have no external pockets. No cargo shorts.

Girls may wear khaki or navy blue (no denim) skorts or skirts. Skorts and skirts should have no external pockets.

All pants, shorts, skirts and skorts

1. Should be of medium tan khaki (not the darkest, but not the near white) or navy blue (no denim).
2. Should be plain with no outside pockets including cargo or jean style pockets.
3. Belts must be worn in Grades K-5 with all pants, shorts, skorts, and skirts that have belt loops.
4. Shorts must be of the walking type, and the bottom of the hem must be no higher than the tip of the wearer's middle finger when the arm is relaxed at the side. This applies to skorts and skirts also.
5. Girls should wear shorts under skirts and jumpers.

Jumpers

Girls may wear jumpers that are khaki or navy blue (no denim). One-piece dresses are not allowed

Dress Uniforms

“Dress Uniforms” must be worn on Mass days. For boys, the “Dress Uniform” consists of khaki pants and the navy blue polo shirt (with logo preferred). For girls, the “Dress Uniform” consists of skirts (not skorts), or jumpers with a white blouse. Cowboy boots may not be worn on Mass days.

Outer Wear

Girls and boys may wear

1. Any jacket that is appropriate for a school setting. Students are never allowed to wear their hoods in the building.
2. Navy blue or white sweaters and sweatshirts (over approved shirts). The sweaters may be pullovers or cardigans. Sweatshirts may be zippered or not.
3. No outerwear may contain logos that would not be appropriate for the Catholic School setting (beer logos, tobacco logos, skulls, bad words, etc.)

Monograms

Polo shirts are encouraged to have the school monogram. Polo shirts may be purchased through school uniform vendors. The school sells a logo patch that can easily be sewn onto the polo shirts through the school office. Vendors in town are available to sew the monogram onto the polo shirt that they sell or onto shirts that are purchased elsewhere. Check with the school office for a list of vendors who will have the expected logo information.

Hair

Students’ hair must be kept trimmed, neatly combed and clean. Hairstyles should not obscure vision or interfere with schoolwork or cause distractions among classmates. Students are not permitted to dye or bleach their hair an unnatural color. Boy’s hair guidelines are as follows: Bangs can be no longer than the eyebrows when held down on the forehead. Hair at sides can be no longer than the middle of the ear. Hair at the back cannot touch the collar. Haircuts that are of a “Mohawk” style or shaved design are not allowed. Hair should not be a distraction to anyone.

Noncompliance

Homeroom teachers and other staff members will report to the office students who are not complying with the uniform requirement. Parents will be notified of uniform

infractions. Three instances of noncompliance in a grading period will result in lunch or after-school detention. The principal makes the final approval of uniform compliance.

OTHER UNIFORM DRESS CODE RULES

1. Shoes and belts should be primarily black, brown, or white. The Principal must approve tennis shoes of another color. Shoes with lights or wheels are not allowed.
2. Open-toed shoes and backless shoes are not acceptable.
3. Socks and leggings should be a solid color: navy, black, gray, or white. No colored trim, patterns, or logos are allowed.
4. Shirts must be tucked in.
5. Caps, gloves and sunglasses are not permitted inside the building.
6. Boys and girls may wear watches and neck chains. No smart watches such as Apple Watches are allowed. Girls' earrings may not be large or long. Boys may not wear earrings.
7. Gym and athletic wear are not permitted in the classroom.
